 - Ocommunity well; well, pump and 10,000 gal. storage system operates as "Bill's Hill Neighbors Association" and is supervised by an independent paid manager. Each household's annual fee for 2024 was \$1,500 to cover on-going, routine operating costs in addition to assessments as needed for extra repairs. All members belong to the "XiO" a computerized water monitoring system; providing water usage reports by household that are published quarterly

 - o Designated generator powering well and pump
